<u>Self-Awareness - From Separation to Self-Regulation</u>

The Infant plays with his toes; the Baby smiles at his reflection in the mirror; the Toddler waves goodbye to his dad; the Two knows his name; the Three loves herself and her friends; the Four enjoys 'Show & Tell' and begins to understand rules; the Five looks forward to Big School.

Expression - From Hunger to Humor

The Infant cries when he's hungry; the Baby signs for 'more' at lunch; the Toddler imitates actions in songs; the Two creates his own dances; the Three pretends to be a lost kitten; the Four loves nonsense poems; the Five puts his feelings into journal drawings and tells ridiculous jokes.

Family - Knowledge, Affection, and Pride - My Family Makes Me Proud

The Infant and Baby react with happiness to their immediate and extended family members; the Toddler plays in the Social Studies/Home Center; the Two imitates family meals; the Three tells family stories; the Four brings family and cultural items for sharing; the Five invites his family to school.

Humanity - Interaction and Action for the Good of All

The Infant smiles at his teacher; the Baby engages in parallel play; the Toddler shares his space without biting; the Two holds hands with a classmate as he walks to the playground; the Three plays whole group games; the Four takes turns; the Five rushes in at arrival to greet his friends.
